

## DCWA Champ Show 2010

### Critiques

#### **Baby dog 1<sup>st</sup> # 01 - Vansitar Game Boy**

Black and tan male. Foreface needs to be slightly stronger, good colour, nice tan, good depth of brisket, nice forechest, good feet, good length – at the moment is fairly square, good angulation at rear end, good tailset.

#### **Puppy Dog 1<sup>st</sup> # 05 - Bravadobe Voodoo**

Black and tan male. Standard sized dog, front legs are not 100%, are slightly pointing out, from pasterns down, depth of brisket is good, topline is good, slightly downfaced, reasonable angulation at rear, feet are not very good, good tan.

#### **Puppy Dog 2<sup>nd</sup> #04 - Valkayrian Ripley Blue**

Blue male, good front, oversized, good bone, good tight feet, head plane is good, slightly lacking a bit in forechest, slightly low in tailset, good bone and colour.

#### **Puppy Dog 3<sup>rd</sup> #03 - Bravadobe Budweiser**

Black and tan male, slightly oversized, good tan, nice eye, good foreface, upright in shoulder, good depth of brisket, straight in rear angulation, rear movement when moving is crossing over.

#### **Junior Dog 1<sup>st</sup> #06 - Modadobe Pemulwuy**

Brown and Tan, good head planes and depth of muzzle, well over standard size for a young dog, upright in shoulder, really good colour, good topline and tailset, good rear angulation, needs to have a bit more body on him, he's not very broad at the moment, and also lacking in spring of rib.

#### **Intermediate Dog 1<sup>st</sup> #08 - Bravadobe Want It Wicked**

Black and tan male, good strong head, good length of head, nice reach of neck, good forechest and topline, good rear angulation, feet are reasonable, movement quite good.

#### **Intermediate Dog 2<sup>nd</sup> #07 - Derringer Time Bomb**

Good head, more upright in shoulder than #1, slightly flatter feet, good topline and tailset, good depth of brisket, good rear angulation, not very well handled.

#### **Intermediate Dog 3<sup>rd</sup> #09 - Vaydee Jesse James (Imp Serbia)**

More European type dog, is heavier toward you, good head, in regards to foreface and strength in head, good neck, good topline, slightly upright in shoulder, good front, good colour tan, good depth of brisket. Rear slightly over angulated, really well handled.

### **State bred Dog 1<sup>st</sup> #10 - Bravadobe Rattle and Hum**

Black and tan male, good topline and tailset, head planes correct, good strength of jaw, straight in front angulation, reasonable rear angulation, depth of brisket well let down, moves quite well and handled really well.

### **State bred Dog 2<sup>nd</sup> #12 - Modadobe Harry High Pants**

Another black and tan, good head planes, another upright in shoulder, reasonable topline and tailset, good colour, nice feet, brisket well let down, and he was well handled.

### **State bred Dog 3<sup>rd</sup> #11 - Plimsol Rockafella**

Brown male, good colour brown, lacking in forechest, slightly downfaced, good strong neck, good topline, slightly low in tailset, good depth of brisket, another upright in shoulder, not much else I can say.

### **Australian Bred Dog 1<sup>st</sup> #13 - Dobenaire Medal of Honour**

Brown and tan, good length of skull, short in muzzle, good neck, good forechest, nice tight feet. For the size of the dog I would have preferred a bit more bone. Good topline, good tailset, good depth of brisket, reasonable rear angulation, fairly well handled.

### **Aust Bred dog 2<sup>nd</sup> #14 - Bravadobe Viva Las Vegas**

Black and tan male, head planes not 100%, slightly downfaced, another upright in shoulder, good topline and tailset, good depth of brisket, reasonable rear angulation, good feet, good colour tan, well handled.

### **Open Dog 1st #16 - Grd Ch Bravadobe Pure Anarchy (AI)**

Brown and tan, good head planes, good topline and tailset, nice forechest, would prefer a little bit more bone in legs, good depth of brisket, good rear angulation, he was really well handled.

### **Open dog 2<sup>nd</sup> #15 - Ch Vanistar Indian Pacific WAC**

Black and tan, good head planes, good strength of muzzle, nice forechest, yet again slightly upright in shoulder, good topline and tailset, good rear angulation, nice depth of brisket, again well handled.

### **Open dog 3<sup>rd</sup>, #17 - Ch Bravadobe Voodoo Magic**

Another black and tan male, good tan, good length of head, strong neck and forechest, good bone, brisket to the elbows, reasonable rear angulation, another upright in shoulder, good colour. Also well handled.

### **Open Dog 4<sup>th</sup> # 18 - Ch Coppertop Rayz A Rumour**

Black and tan male, good head, strong neck, good forechest, good topline and tailset, really over angulated in rear end which also *spoil* him on move. He really didn't move very well, just very lethargic, he's a good colour, and he was well handled, really well handled.

### **Challenge Dog - #16 - Grd Ch Bravadobe Pure Anarchy (AI)**

### **Res Challenge Dog - #08 - Bravadobe Want It Wicked**

The reason I have brought the two winners back in #16 which is the challenge winner and #08 which is the reserve, the both are a similar size, which should have been close to the standard, which these two are. Everything else that I've seen is way way above standard size, angulation on these two is quite good, handling was really good. The winner has a lovely forechest and a lot more like the English style of dog, 27 inches tall or thereabouts. Both good heads, and both good angulation.

### **Baby Bitch 1<sup>st</sup> #19 - Vanistar X Box**

Brown and tan, really nice colour, nice and steady bitch, good bone, nice feet, good topline, she's got a good forechest, good rear angulation, and at the moment she moves quite well.

### **Puppy Bitch 1<sup>st</sup> #21 - Bravadobe Baby Did A Bad Bad Thing**

Brown bitch, lacking in bone, oversized, no forechest, good thing about her is the topline, depth of brisket is not down to the elbows, head planes are not correct, there's not much else to say about it. Movement is erratic.

### **Puppy Bitch 2<sup>nd</sup> #22 - Bravadobe Red Back (AI)**

Black and tan bitch, just don't know what to say. I just do not know what to say. Very poor, very poor from start to finish. Movement absolutely atrocious, there's obviously something wrong with the rear end of the dog, probably damaged or something like that by the look of it. Definitely not a Dobermann.

### **Junior Bitch 1<sup>st</sup> #23 - Vansitar Argyle Diamond**

Brown bitch, nice outline this bitch but again she's oversized, good head planes, nice reach of neck, nice forechest, nice feet, good depth of brisket, good topline and tailset. Slightly over angulated but apart from that a very nice bitch and well handled.

### **Junior Bitch 2<sup>nd</sup> #25 - Modadobe Altjeringa Dreaming**

Another brown bitch, this one is more of a standard size bitch, good head planes, nice reach of neck and forechest, another bitch with nice feet, prefer just a little bit more bone on her, brisket down the elbows, good rear angulation and she was well handed as well.

### **Junior Bitch 3<sup>rd</sup> #26 - Beleg Rhinestone**

Black and tan bitch. Not really a great deal to like about this one. Head planes are not correct, she has good reach of neck, plenty of forechest, slightly overweight, good topline, tailset slightly low, no rear angulation, and didn't move too well, she was pacing all the time.

### **Junior Bitch #27 - Beleg Razzamatazz**

Black and tan bitch, really poor head, very narrow in foreface, wide in skull, reasonable length of neck, upright in shoulder, brisket down to the elbows, rear angulation is not too bad, topline dipping, tailset slightly low.

### **Junior bitch #24 - Bravadobe Soul Stripper**

Black and tan bitch, very fine, tall, good head planes, good length of head, again she's upright in shoulder, oversized, reasonable topline, lacking in bone. She is oversized. There's not much else to say about her.

### **Intermediate Bitch 1<sup>st</sup> #29 - Bravadobe Just Say Yes**

Brown bitch. Good head planes, nice neck, good forechest and some front angulation. Reasonable front bone, good topline, good rear angulation. Well handled.

### **Intermediate bitch 2<sup>nd</sup> #28 - Modadobe Doin Tha Pantz Dance**

Black and tan bitch, good head, nice neck. Good forechest, not much front angulation, good tan, nice topline and tailset, brisket well let down, good rear angulation.

### **State bred Bitch 1st #32 - Sunniva Days Like This CD**

Black and tan bitch, overweight, good length of head and foreface, forechest is reasonable. Not the best topline, tan is a good colour, rear angulation is quite good, front angulation is poor, good depth of brisket, movement lethargic.

### **State bred Bitch 2<sup>nd</sup> #31 - Ch Bravadobe With A Kiss**

Black and tan, not much to say about the head, not much space between skull and foreface, reasonable length of neck. Good topline. Brisket well let down, reasonable angulation at rear end. Cant say much more.

### **State bred bitch 3<sup>rd</sup> #30 - Ch Vansitar Harpers Bazaar**

Not very strong in foreface, no strength of muzzle, upright in shoulder, not a very good topline. Brisket down to elbows, angulation not very good.

### **Australian Bred Bitch 1<sup>st</sup> #34 - Ch Bravadobe Pure Kaos (AI)**

Nice brown bitch, good head, good neck, good topline, slightly low in tailset, good forechest, overweight from having puppies, quite a good rear action, and good rear end.

### **Australian Bred Bitch 2<sup>nd</sup> #33 - Vanistar Sunrise Dam**

Not miss on movement, slightly tall leggy bitch. Black and tan. Good forechest and depth of brisket, good rear angulation. For the size of the bitch I would prefer a little more bone.

### **Australian Bred Bitch 3<sup>rd</sup> #35 - Bravadobe Tear It Up**

Black and tan, good forechest, head mediocre, topline is dipping, low tailset, reasonable forechest, no front angulation, slightly better with the rear angulation.

### **Open bitch 1<sup>st</sup> # 41 - Ch Coppertop Designer Image ET**

Black and tan, reasonable head planes, good reach of neck, nice forefront, slightly upright in shoulder, good topline and tailset, reasonable bone, rear angulation is quite good, handler insists in overstretching her.

### **Open bitch 2<sup>nd</sup> #39 - Ch Bravadobe Achtung Baby**

Another black and tan bitch, reasonable head planes, good reach of neck, slightly upright in shoulder again, good forechest, good colour, nice topline. Brisket down to the elbows, slightly overweight, rear angulation quite good.

### **Open bitch 3<sup>rd</sup> #37 - Vansitar True North**

Black and tan, really good head planes. Nice reach of neck and forechest, upright in shoulder, prefer a little bit more bone to this bitch, depth of brisket down to the elbow, good topline and tailset, reasonable rear angulation, well handled.

### **Open bitch 4<sup>th</sup> #38 - Ch Sunniva Smooth Operator ET**

Black and tan, weak in foreface good head planes, slightly overweight, upright in shoulder, brisket well let down. Plenty of forechest, good topline and tailset, reasonable rear angulation.

### **Open Bitch 5<sup>th</sup> # 40 - Ch Lizmain Southern Belle**

Should definitely not be shown, grossly overweight, very poor head, topline and tailset. The movement was absolutely atrocious.

### **Challenge Bitch - #41 - Ch Coppertop Designer Image ET**

### **Res Challenge Bitch - #29 - Bravadobe Just Say Yes**

I've brought the best bitch back in and reserve best bitch. The best bitch is number 41, quite a good solid bitch, slightly taller than what I would like. She has been very well handled, the handler still insists in overstretching her a little bit, she is quite a nice bitch. Reserve is the brown bitch number 29 which I quite like this bitch she has nice angulation at front. The only thing is she is just lacking that bit of maturity at the moment, I'm sure she will go on to better things.
